



Can IG Railing be used for stairs?

IG Railing spigots, connector brackets, top rail and lighting can be used for stair applications. To maximize connection strength between the glass and spigot and to maximize lighting performance, we recommend using locally supplied “stepped glass”.

Stepped glass will allow maximum contact between the glass, lighting, and IG spigot. Stepped glass is fabricated at local glass shops widely available around the country. The glass will be cut and polished but designed to follow the rise and run of the stairs on a specific project. This is determined by the contractor who will draw a template of the stair section to be covered.



